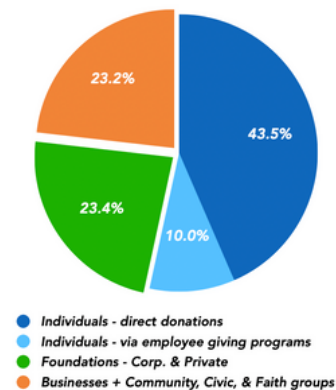

A Pipeline of Future Advocates

- **Hosted 6** HS interns
- **Welcomed youth org's** including Eagle Scouts, VT Seva, Young Men's Service League, Holy Names Academy, Innovation HS, and Hillside School
- **Univ. of AZ** architecture students learned with us for two days
- **UW Architecture** students built a tiny home prototype

Education & Outreach

- We spoke at roughly **100 outreach events**
- New **FAQ and Stories pages** on our website
- Grew our newsletter subscriber **list by 50%**
- Our first **tiny home field trip**
- **Local media** continues writing favorably about tiny homes and villages.

Ongoing Challenges

Slow Pace of Villages

- Village openings stalled in 2024, causing a backup of finished homes. Advocates in local government are funding and pushing for more openings in '25.
- Thousands of neighbors still live on the streets - the problem is harder to solve the longer it takes.
