

2025 Impact Report



113 Tiny Homes built, representing

- approx. **19,888 volunteer hours**
- shelter up to **6780 people** over 20 years
- over **\$508,000** worth of materials purchased

In 2025:


- **More than 2000 neighbors off the streets** via 17 LIHI Tiny Home Villages
- **21 tiny home villages** now open around Puget Sound

We built our 600th tiny home on March 13th and named it:

**"Marvelous Majestic Momentum", a.k.a.
"Big MO!"**

- Over 750 people donated in 2025, **569 (76%) for the first time.**
- Donations through employee giving programs grew by 25% over 2024.
- December was our most successful fundraising month ever.
- Our supporters continue to share that tiny homes are the most desired, effective, & affordable solution to homelessness!

Future & Current Advocates

- Continued hosting **HS interns**.
- **Welcomed youth org's** including Eagle Scouts, VT Seva, Young Men's Service League, Annie Wright School, NCL, and others.
- Continued meeting with **elected officials/ staff** at city, county, and state levels to share and show benefits of tiny homes.

Education & Outreach

- Spoke at more than **50 outreach events**.
- Added Instagram & YouTube channels to our socials.
- Our subscriber **list grew by nearly 1000**.
- Two **tiny home field trips reached over 400 folks** in person in June & August.

Stored Homes

- Although 4 villages opened in 2025, we **continued to work through the backlog of stored tiny homes** resulting from just one new village in '23-'24.
- Thousands of neighbors still live on the streets instead of tiny homes. 2026 PIT Count available this spring.
